Rescue at Sea: US Coast Guard Saves 34 Migrants

In a harrowing incident off the coast of Florida, a vessel carrying 34 migrants began to sink in the waters near Key Colony Beach, prompting a swift response from the United States Coast Guard. Captain Marty Lewis of Main Attraction Sportfishing Charters played a crucial role in alerting the authorities. He spotted the sinking vessel and promptly contacted the Coast Guard, initiating a rescue operation to save the lives of those on board.
